Conservative Spring Forum Registration – FAQ

When is the Conservative Spring Forum?

The Conservative Spring Forum will take place on Friday 17th and Saturday 18th March 2017

Where will the Conservative Spring Forum take place?

The Conservative Spring Forum will be taking place at the SEE SWALEC Stadium in Cardiff. It is a short taxi ride from Cardiff Central Station.

Who can attend the Conservative Spring Forum?

Anyone who has been a member of the Conservative Party for at least 6 months may attend the Conservative Spring Forum and will receive an email inviting them to register. We also extend an invite to all Conservative Parliamentarians, the Media, and select CCHQ and Parliamentary Staff.

Do I need to register before the event to attend? Can I turn up on the day?

Everyone, regardless of which category they register under, **must register online before the event**. Online registration will close on March 1st 2017, at which point if you haven't registered online you will be unable to attend. We will close registration early if we reach capacity.

How do I register?

You should receive a registration code with your invitation email. You can then register at www.conservativespringforum.com. If you did not receive an invitation email, or if you would like to attend but have not previously attended a Conservative Party Conference or Conservative Spring Forum, please email registration@conservativespringforum.com

How much does it cost to attend the Conservative Spring Forum?

The fees for the Spring Forum are as follows:

From 15th December to 27th February prices will be:

- £30.00 for Party Member & Activist
- £15.00 for Party Member & Activist (Student)
- £30.00 for Parliamentary
- £30.00 for Parliamentary Staff
- £100.00 for Commercial Passes
- £75.00 for Charity Passes
- £0.00 for CCHQ Staff & Event Support Staff

After 27th February until 6th March some prices will increase to:

- £60.00 for Party Member & Activist
- £30.00 for Party Member & Activist (Student)
- £60.00 for Parliamentary
- £60.00 for Parliamentary Staff
- £100.00 for Commercial Passes
- £75.00 for Charity Passes
- £0.00 for CCHQ Staff & Event Support Staff

After 6th March it will no longer be possible to purchase passes and there will not be sufficient time to process them ahead of Conservative Spring Forum.

How do I get my pass for the Conservative Spring Forum?

For those who have chosen postal delivery your passes will be posted out in advance of Conservative Spring Forum. For those who have chosen to collect their passes you will need to collect them from the registration desk at the venue. Incomplete registrations will not be printed and you will not be allowed access to the venue.

Where can I find a programme or agenda for the day?

The full agenda for the Conservative Spring Forum will be uploaded to the website on Thursday 16th March.

I can no longer attend the Conservative Spring Forum, can I get a refund?

All passes are non-transferable and non-refundable, however in exceptional circumstances the Conservative Party will issue a refund. Please email registration@conservativespringforum.com to request a refund.

What if I have special requirements in order to attend?
