Conservative Spring Forum Registration – FAQs

When is the Conservative Spring Forum?

The Conservative Spring Forum will take place on Friday 16th and Saturday 17th March 2018.

Where will the Conservative Spring Forum take place?

The Conservative Spring Forum will be taking place in Central London, easily accessible by public transport. The exact location will be emailed to all registered delegates 48 hours before the event, on Wednesday 14th March. This is due to security considerations.

Who can attend the Conservative Spring Forum?

Anyone who has been a member of the Conservative Party for at least 3 months may attend the Conservative Spring Forum and will receive an email inviting them to register. We also extend an invite to all Conservative Parliamentarians, Parliamentary Staff, the Media, and select CCHQ Staff.

Do I need to register before the event to attend? Can I turn up on the day?

Everyone, regardless of which category they register under, must register online before the event. Online registration will close on March 1st 2017, at which point if you haven't registered online you will be unable to attend. The Conservative Party reserves to close registration early if we reach capacity.

How do I register?

You should receive a registration code with your invitation email. You can then register at www.conservativespringforum.com. If you did not receive an invitation email, or if you would like to attend but have not previously attended a Conservative Party Conference or Conservative Spring Forum, please email registration@conservativespringforum.com

How much does it cost to attend the Conservative Spring Forum?

The fees for the Spring Forum are as follows:

From 4th December to 10th February prices will be:

- £35.00 for Party Member & Activist
- £20.00 for Youth Party Member (Under 30)
- £35.00 for Parliamentary

- £30.00 for Parliamentary Staff
- £0.00 for CCHQ Staff & Event Support Staff

After 10th February until 1st March some prices will increase to:

- £70.00 for Party Member & Activist
- £40.00 for Youth Party Member (Under 30)
- £70.00 for Parliamentary
- £70.00 for Parliamentary Staff
- £0.00 for CCHQ Staff & Event Support Staff

After 1st March, it will no longer be possible to purchase passes.

How do I get my pass for the Conservative Spring Forum?

All passes will be posted out the week commencing the 1st March. Please note, there will be **no on-site pass collection available.**

Where can I find a programme or agenda for the day?

The full agenda for the Conservative Spring Forum will be uploaded to the website on Thursday 15th March and you will be able to collect a copy once you arrive.

I can no longer attend the Conservative Spring Forum, can I get a refund?

All passes are non-transferable and non-refundable, however in exceptional circumstances the Conservative Party will issue a refund. Please email registration@conservativespringforum.com to request a refund.

What if I have special requirements in order to attend?
